### Two-Year Commitment-Juniors and PLTW 10<sup>th</sup> Graders

ACTC is recognized as one of the best in the state because of our excellent facility, outstanding faculty and staff, exceptional leadership, and the remarkable students we serve. Since the inception of Technology Centers in this state, we have been accountable for student success, employment, and completion of our two-year programs. Each year we are evaluated by state standards established to see that we meet this and other criteria.

According to state guidelines, we must have two-year technical programs. The sophomore year is simply an introduction to the program to help determine if the student would like to enroll in the two-year program. The two-year program begins the junior year with completion of the second year during the senior year. Many of our programs have more students register for the junior class than space is available. We select students with the understanding that they will complete the program their senior year. Therefore, when a student enrolls in the junior class, it should be with the understanding that he/she will complete the program their senior year.

The student is expected to return to their senior class if he/she is successful in the junior class. Students may not drop the senior class simply because they want an early release or late arrival their senior year. Of course, if there is a scheduling problem the senior year, we will work with the student on that conflict.
